Did you know that beavers have clear eyelids that they can close underwater to help them see while swimming or feeding? Have you ever wondered what it would be like to have clear vision underwater without using a pair of goggles? Well get ready because here is your chance!



Materials:

- Water source
- Aluminum can, recycled plastic container, or ice cream container
- Strong rubber-band
- Clear plastic wrap

Instructions:

- Cut off the bottom of a recycled container or metal can.
- Stretch the clear plastic across the bottom and secure it with elastic bands.
- If you're using an ice cream tub cut out the lid and cut off the bottom. Lay plastic wrap on the top and secure with the lid.
- Next, dunk at least half of the viewer straight into the water and have a look!
- Variation: Have someone place an object somewhere underwater to find. Take turns hiding and seeking objects.

Reflection:

- What is the coolest thing you see?
- How many different colours can you see underwater?
- Are there more aquatic plants or animals in this water source?
