

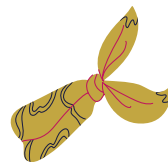
Find Your Tree

Materials: Blindfolds, possibly journals and pencils.

This particular activity is designed to play in groups of two. Adjustments can be made based on the number of participants (use groups of three if necessary). Head outside to a spot that has a variety of species and different sized trees. Be mindful of tripping hazards, as players will be temporarily blindfolded.

Instructions:

- Divide players into pairs. Each team of two will receive one blindfold.



- Everyone will slowly walk their blindfolded partner to a nearby tree that they will get to know carefully. Their challenge is to get to know the tree so well that they can find the tree without the blindfold on!



- Before you start, gently spin your partner. Select a tree and walk your partner to it. Test observation skills or increase difficulty by taking an indirect route to the tree.
