Web Tangle

Instructions:

- Stand in a circle and everyone connects to two different hands (not knowing whose is whose).
- Without letting go, try and untangle the group by going over and under each other's hands, working as a team.
- When the group is untangled, talk about how we are all connected and how one person/creature's actions can affect everything else.

Web of Life Game

Materials: Ball of yarn or string.

Instructions:

- Have all players stand in a circle.
- Ask the first player to hold the end of a ball of yarn and name a creature.
- Next have them pass it across the circle to someone else and name a creature that is connected to the first one, and so on until the yarn has made a web.
- Once every participant is holding a section of string, name a creature in the circle and have them let go. Relate this concept to extinction and how this can impact the entire food chain.
